I dedicate this album to my father, Paul Winter, Sr. (September 27, 1887–October 18, 1987) in celebration of his loving spirit. Dad came from a musical lineage. His grandfather, who emigrated from Germany to America in 1833, was a preacher and musician. His father, as a young man, became a bandmaster in the Civil War, then a piano tuner, and founded a music store in Altoona, Pennsylvania during the 1880's. Dad was surrounded with music throughout his long life. From the time I began playing drums and piano as a little kid, he was right behind me, always encouraging. He gave me my life in music.

Gratitude to my brother & sister musicians who collaborated with me in the making of this music, & to the many friends who have supported Living Music, our productions & expeditions during these first seven years. This music comes from all of us.

Earlier in this century, our government tried to eradicate the wolf. It was largely successful, and now the only significant population of wolves south of Canada is confined to northern Minnesota. But Defenders of Wildlife and other wildlife conservation organizations are spearheading wolf restoration efforts across the country — in North Carolina, in Montana, in the Southwest and perhaps most significantly, in Yellowstone National Park.
